

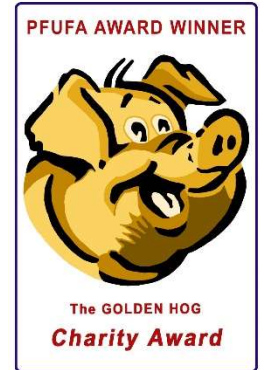

2024 AWARD RECIPIENT – Jeffrey "PorkRine" Rinehart Jr., Washington Commanders

This year the Pro Football's Ultimate Fan Association awarded the 2024 Golden Hog Award to Jeff Rinehart Jr. Jeff is a member of the PFUFA Class of 2020 and is being recognized for exemplifying the conventional definition of charity that is "the practice of giving and caring."

Jeff Rinehart Jr. is one of the founders of the Hogfarmers, but it's the quiet personal support that is outstanding. He text parents, even after their child passed from pediatric cancer and does visits to homes. He follows up with the kids, even after their prognosis improves.

At his charity golf tournament, he was essential in raising \$43,000.00 for men's mental health and supporting families diagnosed with pediatric cancer. Jeff hosts pediatric cancer families to a day off from their battle by attending a Commanders' game. Jeff organized Charity Putt-Putt event raising \$5,000 for family care packages. His organization granted eleven families with \$1,000 grants for Christmas.

Jeff teamed up with former Commanders' DE, Casey Toohill, for a bowling event where they provided patients and siblings with a night off and their own Halloween costumes. Jeff hosts birthday parties for families when each birthday is more important than the last. Collectively they raised over \$100,000.00 for families battling pediatric cancer.
